TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1) **Term:** 1 calendar year (no extensions will be granted)
 - 2) **Appointment status:** If, during the period of the award, the grantee resigns from his/her current appointment with the University, the grant will be terminated. Any unspent funds will be returned to the University.
 - 3) **Financial regulations:** This award is subject to:

- *Research expenses are expected to be in accordance with the approved budget as set out in your grant application. A budget must be resubmitted for approval for deviations exceeding 50% of the total award.
- 4) **Transfers of funds:** Funds cannot be transferred to other institutions.
 - 5) **Compliance certificates:** Funds will only be released on receipt of approval of regulatory clearances, as applicable. If you have not yet initiated the process, please contact the appropriate office(s) without delay:

 - 6) **Affiliation:** Carleton University affiliation must be included on all resulting research outputs.
 - 7) **Promotional purposes:** The summary provided as part of the proposal may be used for promotional purposes.
 - 8) **External grant submission:** Within 12-18 months of notice of decision, this award must lead to a competitive proposal to the stipulated Tri-Council Agency.
 - 9) **Grant facilitation services:** In accepting this award, the grant holder commits to working with their Faculty Research Facilitator on their Tri-Council grant proposal.
 - 10) **Final report:** Grant holders are required to submit a [final report](#) via web-form within 6 months following the award end date, detailing the activities undertaken as a result of this funding, as well as the outcomes and impacts, including research funding proposal submissions.
